

Fulton-EI Camino Recreation and Park District Measure Q Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

Applicant Packet

The Fulton-EI Camino Recreation and Park District is establishing a citizen's bond oversight committee to review expenditures associated with Measure Q, which was approved by voters on November 5, 2024.

Who will be on the Committee?

The Committee shall consist of at least seven members, as appointed by the Board. The Board shall strive to appoint members of the Committee consisting of citizens representing the District's diversity and varied interests, including:

- One member active in a business entity representing the business community located in the District.
- One member active in an organization representing youth in the District.
- One member who is associated with or member of a community-based Organization that partners with the District.
- One member who is active in a taxpayers association.
- One member of a neighborhood association in the District.
- Two at-large members.

What will the Committee do?

The committee will be responsible for making reports to the Board and the community about bond expenditures.

How often will the Committee meet?

It is estimated that the Committee will meet approximately four times per year during periods of construction. Specific meeting dates will be determined by the Committee.

How will the Committee be selected?

The Board will select members of the Committee, taking into account each applicant's professional and/or practical experience, the applicant's recognition in or contribution to his/her community, the diversity of experience on the Committee as a whole, and representation on the Committee from various communities within the district. The Board is expected to appoint the new members of the Committee by April 17, 2025.

What else should the applicant know?

All committee proceedings will be open to the public and will be subject to the Brown Act. All documents and reports received or published by the Committee will be a matter of public record, and will be made available on the District's web site.
