

FEC Stingray Aquatic Teams Swimmers Code of Conduct

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my teammates and other swimmers participating in the Northern California Swim League by following this Swimmers Code of Conduct:

- 1. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating a positive attitude and respect for all players, coaches and officials at every practice and meet or other FEC Stingray event.**
- 2. I will not yell at or degrade my teammates or other teams' swimmers, players, coaches, fans or officials.**
- 3. I will place sportsmanship ahead of my personal desire to win.**
- 4. I will insist that I participate in a safe and healthy environment.**
- 5. I will support coaches and officials working with me, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.**
- 6. I will support my coaching staff by attending meets and practices.**
- 7. I will demand a sports environment free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from them.**
- 8. I will refrain from using profane gestures and language at all FEC Stingray events.**
- 9. I will refrain from inappropriate behavior.**
- 10. I will do my best to make my swim experience fun.**
- 11. I will treat other swimmers, coaches, fans, parents, team parents and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.**

I understand that if I do not conduct myself in a positive and supportive manner that I may be asked to leave a practice or meet by FEC officials. I further understand that repeated violations of the Swimmers Code of Conduct or FEC Rules and Regulations or violations of a serious nature may result in my being dismissed from the team, without reimbursement of fees.

I understand that the above Swimmers Code of Conduct may not include all prohibited behaviors and that FEC Officials reserve the right to determine whether any behavior violates generally accepted behavior standards.
