Applicant needs to possess basic maintenance skills and knowledge related to park maintenance and recreation.

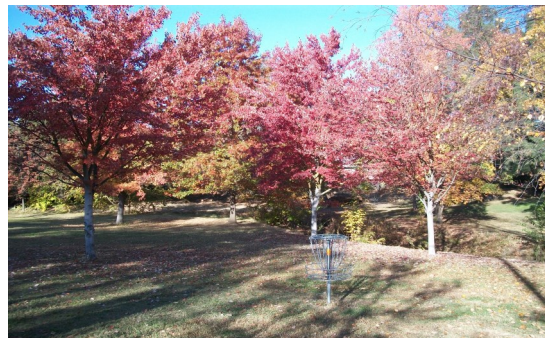
Applicant must possess a valid California Driver’s license and pass a DOJ background check.

**Typical Duties**

- General knowledge of irrigation & time clocks.
- Performs general park maintenance duties pertaining to minor plumbing, carpentry, landscaping, and wildlife areas.
- Knowledge of ballfields to include dragging & general maintenance of fields.
- Knowledge of public pool maintenance and operations; chemicals, pumps, etc.
- Operates power tools, tractors and other light to heavy equipment used in landscape and general repairs.
- Purchases supplies and equipment in accordance with policy and budgeting guidelines.
- Observes and implements district policies and safety practices.
- Ensures that order is maintained in the parks and reports injuries, vandalism, area misuse and other undesirable activities.
- Attends staff meetings, in-service trainings, and workshops.
- Willing to work harmoniously with co-workers and the public.
- Understands that all duties assigned may be altered for the betterment of a project and the District as a whole.
